<p>We have seen a case where JTorX did not start on windows.</p> <p>A 64 bit Windows was running, but no 64bit java was installed.</p> <p>Apparently the test in the jtorx.bat script that is there to decide whether to use 32bit or 64bit swt library could not deal with this.</p> <p>This was worked around by installing 64bit java.</p>
